Fundraising ideas for kids:

1. Challenge everyone involved to feed 100 children and then send them out to friends and family to ask them to sponsor them:

- They take a signup/ sponsor sheet with them and let people know that for only a quarter they can feed one child a full meal with all the nutrition they need for a day, \$1.50 will feed a family of 6. This will add up fast and people will meet their goal in no time. Try to collect the money at the time they sign up.
- Take a Kids Against Hunger flier along to show people what it's all about.
- A bake sale always raises money fast, some schools have sold popcorn balls & taffy...either at school or after church, and if you just ask people for a donation (instead of requesting a certain amount) they are usually generous.
- Set up a little donation box somewhere safe/ with someone nearby(ask permission first)...school, church, a sporting event or a place of business with a flier posted nearby
- If someone's birthday or anniversary is coming up they can ask people to donate to KAH in lieu of a gift.
- One school had a penny war and donated the money to KAH.
