

# Developing a Kids Against Hunger event

## **WHAT** is this activity?

See Power Point slides or DVD for background and visuals on the event, and food packet as example.

## **WHO** participates?

Invitees of Financial Representatives and organizing groups (Congregations and Thrivent chapter board)

Warning about the "blessing of too many volunteers"

## **WHY** do we do this?

To fill empty bellies and food pantry shelves

To provide an opportunity for families to work together, making a difference in the community

## **WHERE** do the meals go?

Distribution is usually a combination of local food pantries and organizations overseas. This is determined by the organizing chapters/congregations.

Freight costs are the responsibility of the receiving organization.

## **WHEN** is the event?

Book your date early, to get the date that works best for your community.

Shift times to be determined based on total meals packed.

## **HOW** is the funding handled?

Cost is \$.25 per meal, with a minimum of 40,000 meals.

## **HOW** many people do we need?

Six packing lines produce 25,000 meals in 2 hours.

At 14 people per line, each shift would need 84 people. Normal events have at least 2 shifts, and pack 50,000 to 75,000 meals.
